

**MINUTES**  
**City Council Study Session**  
**June 17, 2021 – 3:00 p.m.**

**CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL:** Mayor Kuhn called the meeting to order and called roll. Councilmembers Abersold, Denson, Himes, Markley, Rodenberg, and Woock were present with Councilmember Franich excused. City Administrator Bob Larson, Public Works Director Jeff Langhelm, Finance Director Dave Rodenbach, and Interim Clerk Josh Stecker were present from staff.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

**American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) - Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund** – Bob Larson gave an overview of the ARPA Local Fiscal Recovery Fund and the acceptable uses of the \$2.99 million allocated to the City. He presented four options for Council to consider for funding including Civic Center HVAC improvements, Council Chambers audio/video improvements, North Well #9 development and North Harborview Drive Sanitary Sewer replacement.

Council expressed support for funding the Civic Center and Council Chambers improvements and supported funding the Well #9 project over the sewer replacement project. Staff will look into the option of using the funds for potential cost overruns on the construction of the Public Works Operations Center.

**Mayor's Comments** – The Mayor reported that the Finance & Safety Committee would be reviewing options for dealing with the Civic Center debt and debt reserve fund. He also updated Council on the process for placing signage in and around tx<sup>w</sup>aalqøt estuary.
