REQUIREMENTS FOR LAND CLEARING COMPLETE APPLICATION | GHMC 17.94.060

A complete application for a land clearing permit shall be submitted on the application form provided by the city, together with information required under GHMC Title 19 for a completed application, and including the following:

A PLOT PLAN CONTAINING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Date, north arrow and adequate scales as determined by the planning director;

- Prominent physical features of the property including, but not limited to, topography, critical areas and watercourses;
