

MINUTES FOR GIG HARBOR CITY COUNCIL STUDY SESSION
Thursday, March 31, 2022 – 2:00 p.m.
Virtual Meeting

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: Mayor Markley called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. Councilmembers Barber, Denson, Henderson, Lykins, Rodenberg, Storset and Woock were present.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. **Annual Pavement Maintenance Program** – Project Engineer Marcos McGraw and City Engineer Trent Ward presented an overview of the City's pavement maintenance program.
2. **Fireworks Code Amendments** – Building Official/Fire Marshal Paul Rice outlined recent Pierce County legislation that allows the County to suspend fireworks use if fuel moisture content drops measurably. Council directed staff to prepare a similar ordinance for the City that allows fireworks bans based on local measurements.
3. **Council Guidelines Update** – City Clerk Josh Stecker worked with Council to get directions on changes to the City Council Guidelines including adding a land acknowledgement to council agendas and developing policies for public comment. Council asked for further discussion on a social media policy with the City Attorney.
