





## Budget Expenditures 2006-2016




\* Total expenditures less transfers Note: 2015 & 2016 depict budgeted expenditures

## Bond Financing 2006-2016




## Cash Receipts - Volume By Type 2012-2015

- Wire transfers of sales tax, property tax and grant proceeds not included


## Cash Receipts - Amount By Type 2012-2015


## Business Licenses 2006-2015

## Federal & State Grants 2011-2014




